DISPOSITION HEARING - PROBATION REINSTATED WITH VIOLATION HEARING

A record of the proceedings is made by audio and/or videotape in lieu of a court reporter.

The Defendant has previously entered a denial to the alleged violation of probation and now advises the Court that he/she wishes to enter an admission.

The Defendant admits violation of probation for condition #16.

The admission is accepted and entered of record.

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The Defendant is advised of the right to disposition hearing within the statutory time limits and the right to a written probation violation report.

Disposition proceeds at this time

Kathryn Mason and Burton Kruglick address the court.

The Court finds Defendant has violated the conditions of probation previously imposed.

IT IS ORDERED suspending imposition of sentence and, under the supervision of the Adult Probation Department (APD), continuing the defendant on probation:

Count 1: With a revised expiration date of 3/1/2008.

Conditions of probation include the following:

Condition 16 - Restitution, Fines, and Fees:

PROBATION SERVICE FEE: Count 1 - \$50.00 per month, beginning 3/1/2007.

DELINQUENT PROBATION SERVICE FEES: Count 1 - \$145.00 payable \$20.00 per month, beginning 3/1/2007.

ASSESSMENTS:

Count 1: PROBATION SURCHARGE: \$5.00

All amounts payable through the Clerk of the Superior Court.

Condition 17 - Not consume or drink any substance containing alcohol.

Condition 18 - Not have any contact with the victim(s) whatsoever, unless approved in writing by the Adult Probation Department.

Condition 19 - Count 1: Complete 40 hours of approved community work service with credit for hours previously served at a minimum rate of 10 hours per month beginning as directed in writing by the Adult Probation Department.

Condition 21 - Count 1: Be incarcerated in the county jail for two (2) month(s), beginning 8/1/2007 with credit for 0 day(s) served.

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Not to be released until 9/30/2007.

Report to the APD within 72 hours of release from jail. Comply with all program rules.

Defendant shall be screened for Work Furlough.

APD may petition to modify the deferred jail term.

Condition 24 - Participate and cooperate in any counseling or assistance as directed by the APD as noted in the Uniform Conditions of Supervised Probation.

Condition 26 - Other: Defendant shall complete a psychiatric evaluation 4/30/2007 and take as prescribed, any medication.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Defendant be given credit for any monies paid to date.

IT IS ORDERED granting the Motion To Dismiss the allegations of violation of the remaining term(s) as set forth in the Petition To Revoke.

Count(s) 1: IT IS ORDERED Defendant self-surrender to the custody of the Maricopa County Sheriff and authorizing the Sheriff to carry out the term of incarceration.

The written terms and conditions of probation are handed to the Defendant for explanation and signature. The Defendant is advised of the consequences of failure to abide the terms of probation.
