IT IS FURTHER ORDERED affirming the terms and conditions of the Defendant's probation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Adult Probation Department shall continue to monitor the progress of the Defendant's pregnancy and shall notify this Court when the baby is born so that a Status Conference can be scheduled.

LET THE RECORD REFLECT that the Court informs the Defendant and her family and they affirm that any contact between the Defendant and the unborn child will be a violation of the Defendant's probation, and that any violation could result in the Defendant being sentenced to a term of imprisonment in the Department of Corrections. The Court further informs the parties that a specific plan regarding the welfare of the child shall be discussed at the next Status Conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED appointing a Guardian Ad Litem to represent the best interests of the unborn minor child (separate minute entry shall issue).
