IT IS ORDERED that the State shall disclose to the defense all materials or information in the State's possession or control related to Phoenix Fire Department Investigators Fred Andes, Jack Ballentine and Sam Richardson.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that either party in this lawsuit may use the materials or information for any legitimate purpose related to this litigation only, and shall not disclose these materials or information contained therein to anyone outside of this litigation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED prohibiting the parties from discussing or commenting upon the contents of the materials or information with anyone not involved in this litigation. The parties are specifically prohibited from discussing or commenting upon the contents of the materials or information with the media.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if either party uses any of the materials or information as evidence in a hearing, trial, or motion, that party shall submit such records to the court under seal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the materials or information may be disclosed to any expert who may use the records for a report or in trial preparation for testimony. However, the expert is subject to the same restrictions as to the use of the the materials or information as the parties.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if either party disseminates the materials or information to an expert, that party must first inform the expert of the confidential nature of the the materials or information and that any disclosure of the confidential the materials or information by the expert would be a violation of this Court's Order.
