FINE: Total amount of \$750.00, payable \$20.00 per month beginning the first day of the second month after release from DOC as to CR2002-021816. Surcharges are waived.

Fine is to be paid to the Arizona Drug Enforcement Fund.

REIMBURSEMENT: \$100.00 payable \$10.00 per month, beginning the first day of the second month after release from DOC as to CR2002-021816.
