LET THE RECORD REFLECT that Dale Lindsey Howell and Stephen Russell Howell are sworn prior to hearing.

4:12 p.m. This is the time set for a Child Support Enforcement Hearing. Petitioner (Mother), Dale Lindsey Howell, is present telephonically on her own behalf. Respondent (Father), Stephen Russell Howell, is present telephonically on his own behalf. The State is represented by Assistant Attorney General Julie Minnick.

A record of the proceedings is made by audio and/or videotape in lieu of a court reporter.

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Counsel for the State presents the status of the case: This was originally a non-IV-D case; however, Father recently applied for IV-D services. Mother was incarcerated for non-payment of child support and released after paying the \$1,000.00 purge payment. She was granted authority to leave the State and currently resides in Texas; the State will look into pursuing this matter in Texas.

Dale Lindsey Howell, previously sworn, testifies.

Stephen Russell Howell, previously sworn, testifies.

Based upon the testimony presented,

**IT IS ORDERED**, on a temporary basis, that Mother shall pay not less than \$275.00 per month as and for child support as long as she continues to apply for employment.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Petitioner/Mother apply for not less than two (2) jobs per day, five (5) days per week, until full-time employment is obtained, and she begins working 40 hours per week. Petitioner shall maintain a daily log, which contains the name of the businesses to which she applied, the date of the application, the name of a contact person, and a telephone number. Petitioner shall send to the Assistant Attorney General a copy of that log no later than **March 10, 2009**, or whenever she begins full-time employment, whichever occurs first. Thereafter, the Assistant Attorney General shall confirm the content of the log by randomly selecting a reasonable number of entries, unless Petitioner has obtained full-time employment, in which case the Assistant Attorney General shall confirm Petitioner's employment.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** setting this matter for Review Hearing on **March 16, 2009 at 11:30 a.m.** before **Commissioner Colosi** to review Petitioner's employment status and payment history.

On the Court's own motion,

**IT IS ORDERED** granting permission for Petitioner to appear telephonically at the March 16, 2009 Review Hearing. Petitioner must contact the Assistant Attorney General at (602) 372-1949 on the date and time of hearing.

Upon Respondent's request to waive his appearance,

**IT IS ORDERED** waiving Respondent's appearance at the March 16, 2009 Review Hearing.

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**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** signing this Minute Entry as a formal written order of the Court pursuant to Rule 81, Arizona Rules of Family Law Procedure.
