The Court states the parties' areas of agreement on the record for purposes of calculating child support: There is one child under the age of 12. Mother's monthly income is \$4,045.60. Mother pays \$92.00/month for medical/dental/vision insurance. The parties shall continue to alternate Federal and State tax exemptions for the parties' minor child, beginning with Mother claiming the exemption in 2011. The parties currently exercise equal parenting time.

The parties further agree that the effective date of modification of child support is February 1, 2011.

Father, having previously been sworn, now testifies.

Mother, having previously been sworn, now testifies.

The parties present their closing statements.

Based upon the testimony of the parties and the exhibits received in evidence,

IT IS ORDERED taking this matter under advisement.
