Father having withdrawn his Petition to Modify Custody, and Mother having withdrawn her Motion to vacate the Court's order of June 11, 2004,

IT IS ORDERED dismissing any pending petitions/motions of the parties without prejudice, including Mother's Motion for Appointment of Guardian Ad Litem and Motion to Continue Evidentiary Hearing.

By agreement of the parties,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- (1) The Court's orders of June 14, 2004, are vacated.
- (2) The interview of the minor child scheduled with Conciliation Services on July 22, 2004, is vacated.
- (3) The trial set before Judge Raymond Lee on August 6, 2004, is vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for Mother shall prepare and submit a form of order for Judge Lee's approval and signature pursuant to Rule 80(d) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

In the event there is a disagreement over the content of said order, a transcript of this hearing shall be prepared (with the cost equally shared by the parties) and submitted to Lawrence Marks for determination.
