MINUTE ENTRY

This is the time set for Settlement Conference. Petitioner/Mother is present and is represented by counsel, Helen R. Davis. Respondent/Father is present and is represented by counsel, Lori B. Patrick.

The Court notes that the parties have reached an interim partial agreement in this matter relating to temporary child support and personal property issues.

Counsel for Petitioner/Mother recites the agreements on the record as follows:

1. Respondent/Father shall pay child support to Petitioner/Mother in amount of \$417.00 per month beginning on the day Petitioner/Mother moves from the community apartment.
2. Each party will pay one-half of the child daycare expenses.
3. Respondent/Father will register the minor child for insurance benefits at his new job.
4. The parties have agreed to partial division of personal property as follows:
Petitioner/Mother may take the following:
 1. The coffee table;
 2. The television in the living room;
 3. The VCR in Arianna's room;

4. The wooden leather chair;
5. The dining room set, including table chairs hutch and buffet;
6. Arianna's television;
7. The vanity;
8. Arianna's dresser and night stand;
9. The desk in the garage;
10. The lamps, except for the lamps that will be itemized for Respondent/Father;
11. Her grandmother's vanity and chair in the master bedroom;
12. The Montero with the \$7,200.00 encumbrance.

Respondent/Father will receive the following:

1. The entertainment center;
 2. The television in the bedroom;
 3. The master bedroom bed and dresser;
 4. Arianna's mattress;
 5. Arianna's old dresser;
 6. The computer;
 7. The play station;
 8. The CD player;
 9. The surround system;
 10. The two end tables;
 11. The lamps in Arianna's room;
 12. The computer table in the closet;
 13. The Dodge Stratus with encumbrance.
5. The parties will divide the kitchen (dishes, pots, pans, forks, knives, small appliances etc). Using alternating picks, they flip a coin to determine who has the first picks, etc.
 6. Counsel notes that the division of the televisions is an interim division pending further agreements by the parties.

Kristina Porter states that she has heard the above statements and understands that this is a binding agreement.

Keith Porter states that he has heard the above statements and understands that this is a binding agreement.

The Court finds that there is a reasonable basis for the agreement and the parties have entered into it voluntarily.

The Court notes that counsel for Respondent/Father will submit a form or Order no later than October 1, 2003.
