**IT IS ORDERED** on a temporary basis, denying Petitioner/Paternal Uncle's Motion for Temporary Orders for Legal Decision-Making Authority (Custody) and Parenting Time by Third Party filed on July 11, 2013.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** on a temporary basis the minor children shall continue to reside with Respondent/Mother.

LET THE RECORD REFLECT that the Court suggests to counsel and the parties, that a Parenting Skills class would be beneficial in this matter.

LET THE RECORD FURTHER REFLECT that the Court suggests to counsel and the parties that it would be appropriate for all parties to find alternate means of punishment in place of corporal punishment for the minor children.
