Having considered the testimony of the parties,

**THE COURT FINDS** by a preponderance of the evidence that there is reasonable cause to believe that Defendant has committed an act of domestic violence within the last year. Based upon the mutual violence that the parties exhibit towards each other this Court strongly suggest to the Family Court that it consider modifying the parenting arrangement to reflect that exchanges of the child at the police station, however, this Court is not going to change the parenting plan at this time, because the parties are not in agreement and this Court does not have the ability to change the parenting plan.

The Court finds it appropriate that the order of protection issued on September 29, 2011 be modified as stated on the record in open Court and reflected in the Order of Protection-amended signed by the Court this date.

**THE COURT FURTHER FINDS** it appropriate that the Order of Protection be modified as follows:

1. Defendant/Annie C. Konboz may contact Plaintiff/Tavit Kazanjian only by email and/or text messaging; however, contact is limited to parenting time issues only.
2. Defendant shall not go on or near any place where Plaintiff resides at 2211 W. Morrow dr., Phx, AZ 85027 or workplace at Adagio Beauty Supply at 7366 E. Shea Blvd. Unit 110; Scottsdale, AZ 85260.

This order is without prejudice as to any future family Court orders, exchange of the child shall occur at an agreed public location. If there is not written agreement or family Court order, the Defendant shall not take or approach the child.
