CHILD SUPPORT MODIFICATION HEARING

3:08 p.m. This is the time set for a Child Support Modification Hearing on Respondent's *Petition to Modify Child Support*, filed on July 17, 2013. Petitioner/Mother, Patricia Martinez, is present on her own behalf. Respondent/Father, Darangelo Balark, is present on his own behalf. The State is represented by Assistant Attorney General, Alejandra Valdez.

A record of the proceedings is made by audio and/or videotape in lieu of a court reporter.

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Patricia Martinez and Darangelo Balark are sworn.

Counsel for the State advises the Court of the State's position and recommendations.

Darangelo Balark testifies.

Patricia Martinez testifies.

Based on the information and testimony presented in open court,

THE COURT FINDS that the relevant financial factors required to be included, and the discretionary allowances and adjustments which the Court will allow, for a current calculation of child support pursuant to the Arizona Child Support Guidelines are set forth in the Child Support Worksheet submitted to this Court by the Assistant Attorney General, which the Court hereby incorporates and adopts as its findings with respect to child support.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the calculation does not reflect an unjust or inappropriate amount. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED granting Respondent's *Petition to Modify Child Support*. In accordance therewith,

IT IS ORDERED that Father shall pay the sum of \$250.92 as and for current child support commencing October 1, 2013 and continuing on the same day of each month thereafter. Said amount is to be paid through the Support Payment Clearinghouse by Order of Assignment.

LET THE RECORD REFLECT that no arrears are owed in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED any uninsured medical or dental costs shall be split amongst the parties with the Father paying 56% of the costs and Mother paying 44% of the costs.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Father and Mother shall alternate tax years with the Mother to claim the child in 2013 and all odd tax years; Father in 2014 and all even tax years. Father is entitled to utilize the exemption for the minor child provided he is current in the payment of all current child support and child support arrearage payments due by December 31 of the year applicable to the exemption.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State shall submit a Judgment and Order, which sets forth the Court's findings as stated on the record, to the Court for review and signature.

An electronic modified Income Withholding Order will be initiated upon the Court's receipt of said Judgment and Order.
